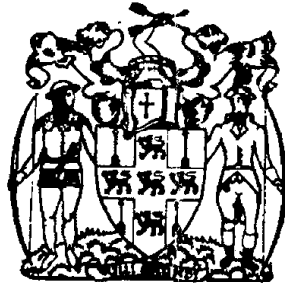


Northern Counties Flight Championships

The 2007 Northern Counties flight championships were shot on the 12th August. Outside of the National championships, this continues to be one of the best attended flight shoots in the country, and this year was no exception as 23 competitors shooting 48 classes gathered at RAF Church Fenton. The weather was less than kind, with our normal shooting line being under several inches of water and we had to use an alternative section of the base. Soon after the first end started so did the rain, with a 15 minute heavy shower doing nothing to dampen the enthusiasm of the archers. Unfortunately, the wind was less welcome with a very blustery head wind making for much reduced distances overall. Despite that (and subject to ratification), three national records were broken on the day and two claims for classification made.
