## **WA Interpretations**

Book 2, Chapter 9.2.2 (last bullet)

Austria Archery has requested an interpretation on the proper scoring of an arrow which hits a horn on a 3D target, passes through the horn, and then hits the scoring area of the target.

Response from the Field & 3D Archery Committee:

It is opinion of the Field & 3D Archery Committee that if the arrow passes through the horn or hoof of a 3D target and is then in contact with a scoring zone, the arrow will

score the value where it touches the body colour zone. However, if the arrow passes through the horn or hoof but does not contact a body colour zone, the arrow is scored as a miss.
