Below you will find details of what to expect when you arrive at the competition and how the shooting will be organised during the day.

Whilst we are officially out of Covid restrictions the shoot will maintain some of these.

Please answer to yourself the following questions. You should consider carefully when you head for the shoot on Saturday/Sunday morning:

| Arrival | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Please do not arrive before 7.30am on Saturday or Sunday• If camping you should not arrive before 12 noon on the Friday. |

| Parking | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unless having arrived with camping facilities on the Friday evening the Tournament field will not be accessible to vehicles unless a disabled archer. • Any archers camping on the Saturday night only, will not be allowed on the Tournament/Camping field until the days shoot has finished. • Parking will be in the field the portable toilets are situated and as indicated by signage. • Leave plenty of room between vehicles to ensure social distancing. • Access to the field will be via the walkway through the fencing. |
| Tent Areas | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is adequate room behind the shooting line, but to ensure we can all socially distance we're asking you to pitch your tents along your target lane edge facing into the lane, this gives circulation space and plenty of room to get to the waiting area. • Tents should not be erected with their doors facing forwards. |
| Inspection | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judges will not touch any of your equipment. • If Bow scales are used for compounds they will be sanitised by the Judges between use. |
| PPE & Sanitiser | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please provide whatever PPE you feel comfortable with • Bring your own hand sanitiser. |
| Food & Drink | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A catering van will be present on the tournament field |
| Toilets | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portable toilets will be available on site. • Sanitiser will be provided next to the toilets |
| Shooting Procedure | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please ensure social distancing at all times • Please keep bows and scopes in front of the tent line, in the spaces allocated. • Scopes may be required to be removed from the shooting line. • The Judge in charge will give further instruction on the day. |
| Scoring etc | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One person will be responsible for the score board at all times. • It is the archer's responsibility to ensure the scorer records the correct scores that are called out. • You must maintain social distancing at all times while at the targets. • You are responsible for pulling your own arrows from the target. • You should not touch any other archer's arrows. |

| | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The field party will assist with looking for any lost arrows but will not touch arrows.• When score sheets need to be handed in, they should be signed using your own pen and placed in the box at the Judges tent.• Any claims for Records, Rose Awards or 6 gold end claims should be made at the Judges tent on the day the claim is made. |
