## Regional Conference

Following the NCAS committee meeting and due to work commitments the date for the Regional Conference has been moved to the 27<sup>th</sup> of January as there were concerns about the weather. The conference will take place at Wetherby and District Social Club, Sandbeck Way, Wetherby LS22 7DN. The conference will run from 1030 till 1600. Tea and Coffee will be available throughout and lunch will be provided.

The first part of the conference will be handed over to an open forum meeting for you to raise anything that you wish with me and anything you wish me to raise with the Judges committee at the JLO meeting in February.

Other topics will include multi-spot scoring and the new J-forms.

NCAS has recently acquired a set of weights, these have been certificated and I hope to be able to use them to carry out bow-scale calibrations at the conference. I am waiting to hear back from AGB about this.

- Role will need to be completed for all days, with training used for conferences and seminars.
