Rules WA Rules of Shooting shall apply with the following adopted;

- a. At 90m, 70m and 60m distances, ends of 6 arrows will be shot in 4 minutes.
- b. There will be 4 archers per boss shooting in 2 details.
2. Should the Tournament be terminated early, the score up to and including the last completed end will decide the awards.
3. World Archery dress regulations (book 3 Chapter 20) will apply.
4. Current AGB affiliation identity cards/electronic membership cards to be shown at registration.
