Rules for the Meeting

- **The shoot is 2 way at 80 yards**
- The competition shall be open to all ladies of 18 years and over
- **The Ascham Silver Arrow** will be awarded to the lady archer who first pierces the inner Gold at 80 yards. Should there be two or more arrows at one end, the arrow nearest the pinhole shall be adjudged the winner.
- Other trophies/prizes will be awarded for:

First or best Red (Recurve or Longbow)	
Most Hits (Recurve)	Most Hits (Longbow)
Best Gold (Recurve)	Best Gold (Longbow)
Highest Score (Recurve)	Highest Score (Longbow)
Most Golds (Recurve)	Most Golds (Longbow)
Most Reds (R & L)	Most Blues (R & L)
Most Blacks (R or L)	Most Whites (R or L)
Worst White (Recurve)	Worst White (Longbow)
Best scoring arrow after luncheon (Recurve or Longbow)	
- Team Prize (1 Recurve and 1 Longbow archer from the same Club)
The winners of **The Ascham Silver Arrow** and First, or Best Red are also eligible to win other trophies e.g. Worst White, Best Gold and Team. Ties or equal scores will be resolved according to the current AGB Rules of Shooting.
- Shooting will be at 80 yards, - 2 way – shooting 3 arrow ends - The inner gold shall be a black disk 2" in diameter. **The inner gold for longbows shall be deemed the "10" ring marked on the target.** Any non-scoring arrow is a "green".
- Shooting shall commence at 11.00 a.m. and continue for one and a half hours, after which **a buffet** luncheon shall be taken. Competitors are expected to take lunch with The Society and failure to do so may result in exclusion from the afternoon's shooting. Grace will be said before lunch. During lunch the Chairman will propose the Loyal Toast and toast to **The Ascham Silver Arrow** and First and Second Ladies. At the conclusion of the meal the Chairman may give a short address.
- The competition will continue for a further one and a half hours after luncheon. The award of **The Ascham Silver Arrow** and other trophies will follow the end of the shooting.
- A subscription "Gold Sweep" will take place the proceeds being divided: A £1 subscription fee will be collected on the day.

Second Best Gold	30% of sweep
Third Best Gold	20% of sweep
- Ladies are placed on their honour to keep their own scores accurately and completely and to submit their scores during the Tournament.
- Compound and crossbows are excluded.
